## Minutes of Annual General Meeting Held Friday 17 April 2026 at 7pm Calthorpe Arms, London WC1

**Present:** 34 members were present

1.	<b>Apologies for absence</b> were received from 10 people.
2.	<b>Minutes of previous AGM</b>  These were agreed as a true and correct record. There were no matters arising.
3.	<b>Treasurer's report and Statement of Accounts</b>  Miu presented her report and the accounts for 2025-26. It was noted that reserves remain high relative to net expenditure. It is proposed that some of this money should be allocated to marketing, in particular focusing on attracting a younger age group.  John Wray proposed that the accounts be adopted; seconded by Richard Philpott.  The accounts and budget were accepted by the meeting.
4.	<b>Chair's report</b>  Paul Foster presented his report to the meeting.  There was some discussion about <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• How to build membership with suggestions to advertise on Let's Ride and to affiliate with British Cycling. This will be considered by the committee.</li><li>• How to even up the rides (currently 2* are heavily subscribed; 3* less so).</li><li>• How to encourage people to lead rides.</li></ul> It was noted that anyone wanting to try a different ride (eg starting earlier or on a different day) should advertise it to gauge response.

7.	<p><b>Consideration of motions submitted</b></p> <p>No motions were submitted.</p>
8.	<p><b>Any other business</b></p> <p>Concern was raised about people's personal details being on the website and this had put some people off leading a ride. It was suggested that surnames and phone numbers don't need to be visible on the site. Individuals should also be mindful about the information that they are sharing when contacting riders.</p>
